Dear Parent/Carer,

As you know your child will be sitting their **SATs** (Statutory Assessment Tests) on the week beginning the 11th May. To ensure the children are best prepared for these national tests we will be carrying out mock tests in the week after the Easter break. More information about the SATs can be found on the [Information for Parents leaflet](#) published by the Government Standards and Testing Agency.

To help support the children to do their best we will be offering them a **free breakfast** each morning between **8:40am and 8:50am** when the children come into school. Children will be offered a choice of a bagel or toast during the week of the mocks, with the additional choice of a bacon roll during SATs week.

Please note, any child late into class will not benefit from this free breakfast.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of these tests which will be used by the secondary schools. It is therefore essential that your child is **in school every day on time**. Children who are late or absent will have to sit the tests at a later time or date on their own, a situation we wish to avoid wherever possible.
