Dear Parent/Carer,

As you know, in preparation for the SATs exams in May and your child's transition to secondary school, we have increased the amount of homework set for our year 6 children.

Your child will be given GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) papers periodically to complete at home to support the learning they are doing in class. The next set of papers will be sent home today to be completed and returned to school on Tuesday 7th January.

The aim is for your child to be able to complete the work independently; if they find it too difficult, please let your child's teacher know via their home school diary.

The homework should take approximately 45 minutes to complete – please help your child to establish good routines about when and how they complete their work at home as establishing these now, in their final year at primary school, will support their transition to secondary school next year.

In the spring term, written formal homework will increase in frequency. Instructions and when it should be returned to school will be recorded by your child in their home school diary.
