

# Spelling Patterns and WWNTK

## Year 3 Summer 1

Learning **spelling patterns** helps children to read, spell and write words.

Each week, children explore a spelling pattern that they practise regularly in class.

Children are also expected to find words that fit the spelling pattern when reading independently at home.

**WWNTK** (Words We Need To Know) are a mixture of words children frequently use in their writing and those which they often misspell.

Week	Spelling Pattern	Example Words	WWNTK revision
1	Add the suffix –ed	admitted controlled preferred visited	suppose favourite
2	Add the suffix –sion	decision explosion television	enough different
3	Add the suffix -tion	invention hesitation completion	thought opposite
4	Add the prefix in-	inactive incorrect invalid	though probably
5	Add the prefix il-	illegal illustration	although perhaps
6	Add the prefix ir-	irregular irresponsible	through believe
