**Year 6 Residential Trip to PGL  
Grosvenor Hall  
Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2027**

Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope, if your child accompanied the trip, they had a great time at Skreens Park this week.

We are now looking ahead to next year and planning the year 6 residential trip to Grosvenor Hall. The trip will be for three nights from **Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> June until Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2027** and the children will be following an *Adventure programme*, which will provide them with the opportunity to participate in activities such as climbing, abseiling, problem solving and fencing. More information, as well as a short video showing a previous trip, can be found on the [Year 6 Residential Trip](#) area of the school website.

The trip is a fantastic opportunity for the children to develop their independence and confidence as well as their ability to socialise and work collaboratively with others before starting secondary school.

The total cost of the trip is £330 which includes travel by coach, full board accommodation and a full programme of activities.

To hold a place, a deposit will need to be **paid via Arbor by the 29<sup>th</sup> June**.

**Payments should be then be made in instalments according to the schedule below:**

To secure a place on the trip, please complete the [Year 6 Trip to PGL 2027 online form](#) by **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June**. **Once the form has been completed a payment option will appear on your Arbor** account (please note, this may take up to one working day). Further payments should then be paid in line with the schedule.

We have to pay PGL for the children’s places on the **30<sup>th</sup> June 2026**, therefore please ensure you secure your child’s place as soon as possible as places **may not** be available after this date. To make the trip financially viable we need a minimum number of children. There is also a limit to the number of children we can take and if this is exceeded, places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
