## Year 3 Trip to Barleylands Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our topic work on '*What Does it Mean to Grow?*' in the summer term, we are planning on taking year 3 on a trip to Barleylands Farm Park on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> April.

In order to cover the cost of the coach and entry to the farm, we are asking for a voluntary donation of **£20**. As the trip will be taking place in the summer term, it is possible to pay in installments.

Permission for your child to go on the trip should be made via Arbor when you pay for the trip. *Please be aware that the school does not receive additional funding to pay for trips and therefore without sufficient contributions, the trip will be cancelled.*

The trip will take place during the school day so children should arrive at the normal time and be picked up from the playground at the end of the day as usual.

Your child should wear their school uniform and have a waterproof coat on the day of the trip. They will also need a water bottle, snacks and a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of free school meals or you would like to order a school packed lunch, please ensure it is booked via Arbor **at least two days before the trip**.

Children should also take any travel sickness tablets before we leave. Additional tablets must be accompanied by the appropriate medical form which can be obtained from the school office.
