Dear Parent/Carer,

In preparation for the upcoming SATs exams in May and the transition to secondary school in September, from this week, the amount of homework set for our year 6 children will start to increase.

On Thursday your child will be given a GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) paper which they should complete and return to school by Tuesday 27th February.

After the half term break the children will also be given maths homework each week (in addition to their KIRFs), to be completed and returned the following week.

In addition to this, two further GPS papers will be sent home to be completed over the Easter holiday, which should be returned to school on Tuesday 16th April.

Please be aware that children should continue to complete their usual homework in line with other year groups i.e. to read regularly, learn their KIRFs, practise their tables and learn their spelling patterns and the 'words we need to know'.

If you have any concerns related to the increase in homework, please contact your child's class teacher.
