Year 6 Homework

As you know, in preparation for the SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) in May and your child's transition to secondary school, we have increased the amount of homework set for our year 6 children.

Your child will be given GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) papers periodically to complete at home to support the learning they are doing in class. The next set of papers will be sent home on Thursday 12th February to be completed and returned to school on Tuesday 24th February.

From the 12th March, your child will bring home weekly maths homework. This homework will be sent home each Thursday and should be completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday.

The aim is for your child to be able to complete the work independently; if they find it too difficult, please let your child's teacher know via their home school diary.

Each piece of homework should take approximately 45 minutes to complete – please help your child to establish good routines about when and how to complete their work at home as establishing these now, in their final year at primary school, will support their transition to secondary school next year.
